






















Concrete work next week. Wait 2-3 weeks to cure then they'll jump on it hard. We should be in before inventory. I hope so, we're busting @ the seams.




And <u>Mike McMahon</u> has been keeping rebuilds and PTOs flowing out of the shop non stop!
