


Kevin Gorman will do any needed drywall repair, clean out the desks/offices, and facilitate the remaining small shipments of items out to either NAPP or Chesapeake.

Kevin along with the Cincy crew were more than appreciative of your participation in providing Kevin tl proper send off.







During the transition from Jacksonville, Lauderdale acquired the overhead crane system used in the test stand/clean area. We will begin to incorporate that into the Lauderdale shop in Q1 and we cannot wait to show you the results! This will allow us to complete testing on a unit then go right to paint on the same trolley/beam, with no handoffs. Big stuff is coming!!

Loaded it in Jax on Friday morning; delivered to Lauderdale Saturday at 8AM (wasn't planned, but thankfully I was there!)

I want to give a special "Shout Out" to Rusty Whitaker and Clayton Howell; the three of us (along with the former Jax personnel) busted our humps in packing up inventory, tooling, unit cores and every other thing you can think of to get Jacksonville buttoned up as diligently as possible.

A lot of 12+ hour days, a few Saturdays and several boomerang trips (from Jax to Lauderdale and/or Tampa and BACK the same day) made this possible and as smooth as we could do.

I also want to credit the Tampa team for their assistance as well – Steven, Willy Earl, Marquese and last (but not least) Miriam for tolerating both Rusty and I yelling at each other when we were on the phones!!!!













Ft. Lauderdale has developed a strong relationship with a local engine dealer (Sun Power Diesel) and it's led to increased gear sales as well as upfit opportunities. SPD sold an FPT engine that needed an MG5146A for a 53' lobster boat repower in Marathon FL. The boat owner was out of commission due to illness, but we held the engine and transmission until they were ready to re-do the engine bed and stringers.

The Lauderdale branch installed the requested live PTO, mounted the gear/torsional coupling and gave it a good coat of marine white paint. We also supplied inlet and outlet hoses for the heat exchanger and a drain hose for the gear. The trans and engine both shipped right at the end of October, with the intent of this boat fishing before Christmas.











We are also working with SPD for some repower opportunities and vessel fleet expansion for Water Taxi Fort Lauderdale. Current fleet is 12 boats but with some recent acquisitions, they could be running a fleet of over 30+ vessels. A majority of them are older Twin Disc models (505, 507-1, 5114RV) but they're standardizing engine packages to John Deere and Yanmar, pairing up with MG5065A and MG5082A series transmissions. Bill Walker(president of WTFL) is pleased that our location is less than 10 minutes away and based on vessel information being collected we're discussing holding customer specific swing units in stock for just in case support.
